It doesn't matter if it's a super single vineyard Barolo such as Bric del Fiasc or the traditional blended Barolo, the Scavinos make wines that highlight the uniqueness of the soils and microclimates of their very special terroirs. Watch the subtle changes in winemaking from Enrico's daughter Elisa – it's all about finetuning what her father began.
