

Barolo D.O.C.G. Monvigliero



The Wine

This Barolo comes from the homonymous vineyard of Monvigliero that can be properly considered the "grand cru" of Verduno village. This cru was first vinified in 2000 vintage and blended into the Barolo until the 2007 vintage when this vineyard has been bought by the Scavino family and made as a single cru.

Great finesse and aromatic complexity, distinctly floral spicy, savory, balsamic in its expression. The nose is vivid and compound. The texture is focused. An extremely elegant cru, feminine and full of character.

The Vineyard

Village: Verduno Cru: Monvigliero Altitude, Exposure: 310 mt, south-east Soil: predominantly limestone, light colored mixed with chalky veins quite characteristic of this commune. Planting year: 1968, 2005

The Grape

Nebbiolo
